100 years of dedication for the well-being of students

At the end of the First World War, a war kitchen was housed in the main building of the University of Bonn. The first "Mensa academica" emerged from this concept in the summer of 1919. Self-help was the order of the day. On 19 September 1919, students founded the association Studentenwohl e.V., which grew into the Studierendenwerk Bonn – the oldest of its kind in Germany.

The then rector of the University of Bonn, the moral theologian Professor Fritz Tillmann, was a strong supporter of the new association from the very beginning and took over its chairmanship in 1923. He is also regarded as the initiator of the first newly-built student residence in Germany, which was constructed in 1923/24 at Lennéstrasse 28 in Bonn's Südstadt district. To this day, the Studierendenwerk's headquarters is still based at the Carré Lennéstrasse, Nassestrasse and Kaiserstrasse.

Providing a warm meal marked the beginning of the association's activities. Offers like accommodation, contracts for work (jobs) and loans were later added and expanded by the inclusion of BAföG (1970s) and child care (2000).

In 1974, the association became a public institution – a public undertaking with a statutory mandate. Its core tasks have essentially remained the same over the past 100 years: a focus on the well-being of the students. MENSA&CAFÉ INTERNATIONAL KI

We are a modern service provider for students of the University of Bonn, the Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University of Applied Sciences as well as their employees. Our goal is to simplify the everyday life of more than 45,000 students in the university area of Bonn/ Rhein-Sieg.

Around 400 employees take care of the basic conditions for successful studies and relieve students of their everyday worries, allowing them to focus on the success of their education. With us, they can eat, live, claim financial assistance and much more.

Our canteens and cafeterias are well-distributed to be as close as possible to university sites. We operate 30 residential units with currently about 4,000 spots and child daycare centres (Kita) for a total of 231 children. The Education Assistance Office helps fund studies (BAföG) and advises on alternative financing options. Our department of international matters actively supports international students. Additionally, we offer a Psychological counselling centre for students feeling overburdened.

The Studierendenwerk Bonn is a non-profit institution under public law (AöR).

Studierendenwerk Bonn operates five canteens (i.e. Mensa), eight cafeterias and a bistro on its sites in Bonn-Zentrum, Bonn-Poppelsdorf, Bonn-Venusberg as well as Sankt Augustin and Rheinbach. Furthermore, we oversee five day care centres.

We excel in high quality standards and offer a wide range of healthy and affordable meals for students, staff and guests. While serving more than 7,000 meals per day, we always focus on balance, variety and consistent nutritional quality.

Studierendenwerk Bonn operates a total of 30 housing units with currently about 4,000 spots at the locations Bonn, Sankt Augustin and Rheinbach. Students of the University of Bonn and the Bonn-Rhein-Sieg University of Applied Sciences are eligible and in primary consideration for accommodation.

Available housing offers ranges from single rooms through apartments to flat-sharing communities and family apartments for students with children. Additionally, there are suitable apartments for students with disabilities.

The monthly rental prices for single rooms currently start at 177 Euros, for apartments at 182 Euros and family apartments at 412 Euros. Rents include all incidental expenses, including broadband internet connection and depend on location, type of housing, room size and amenities. A list of all residential units is accessible on our website.

Online application at any time

Online application for student accommodation is possible at any time on the website of the Studierendenwerk Bonn. The allocation of rooms is based on the chronological order of receipt of the application. An early application is therefore advisable. The maximum period of residence is usually six semesters. All residential units are easily accessible by public transport.

Financial aid for students – BAföG & student loans

Studies last between three and five years. Therefore, the topic "How can I finance my studies?" is on the minds of many prospective students. For those who can not be supported by their parents, it is recommended to make use of the BAföG (Federal Training Assistance Act) financial aid as their best option. Non-Germans are also entitled to BAföG payments. As a rule, foreigners who have prospects of remaining in Germany and are already integrated in society are entitled to support. As the legal regulations are very complex, it is advisable to contact our BAföG-offices at an early stage.

To receive BAföG, one must apply at the Education Assistance Office (in our case, at the Studierendenwerk Bonn). Application is possible at every time. However, it should be done as early as possible. Nowadays, this is also available online.

BAföG-Office

The BAföG-Office is an excellent place to generally clarify questions regarding BAföG applications, student loans and to receive detailed information.

In addition to BAföG, there are various other ways of financing and funding. We are happy to individually advise you and discuss your way forward. It involves the following financing options:

- Daka loans (loans from the Darlehenskasse of the Studierendenwerke NRW e.V.)
- Financial aid for graduation (according to § 15 3a BAföG)
- Education Loan (from the federal government)
- KfW Student Loan.

Studying as a parent – Child care

Studierendenwerk Bonn is the carrier of five daycare centres (Kita) with a total of 15 groups for 231 children aged four months up to the age of school enrollment. At the three university locations Bonn, Rheinbach and Sankt Augustin, we actively support the compatibility of studies, science and family. We mainly offer 45 hours of child care per week and also full-day care.

In addition, Studierendenwerk Bonn also cooperates with the University of Bonn, the General Students' Committee (AStA) and the association La Familiär e.V. to offer a flexible child care, which is available for the late afternoon or early evening in Bonn.
